

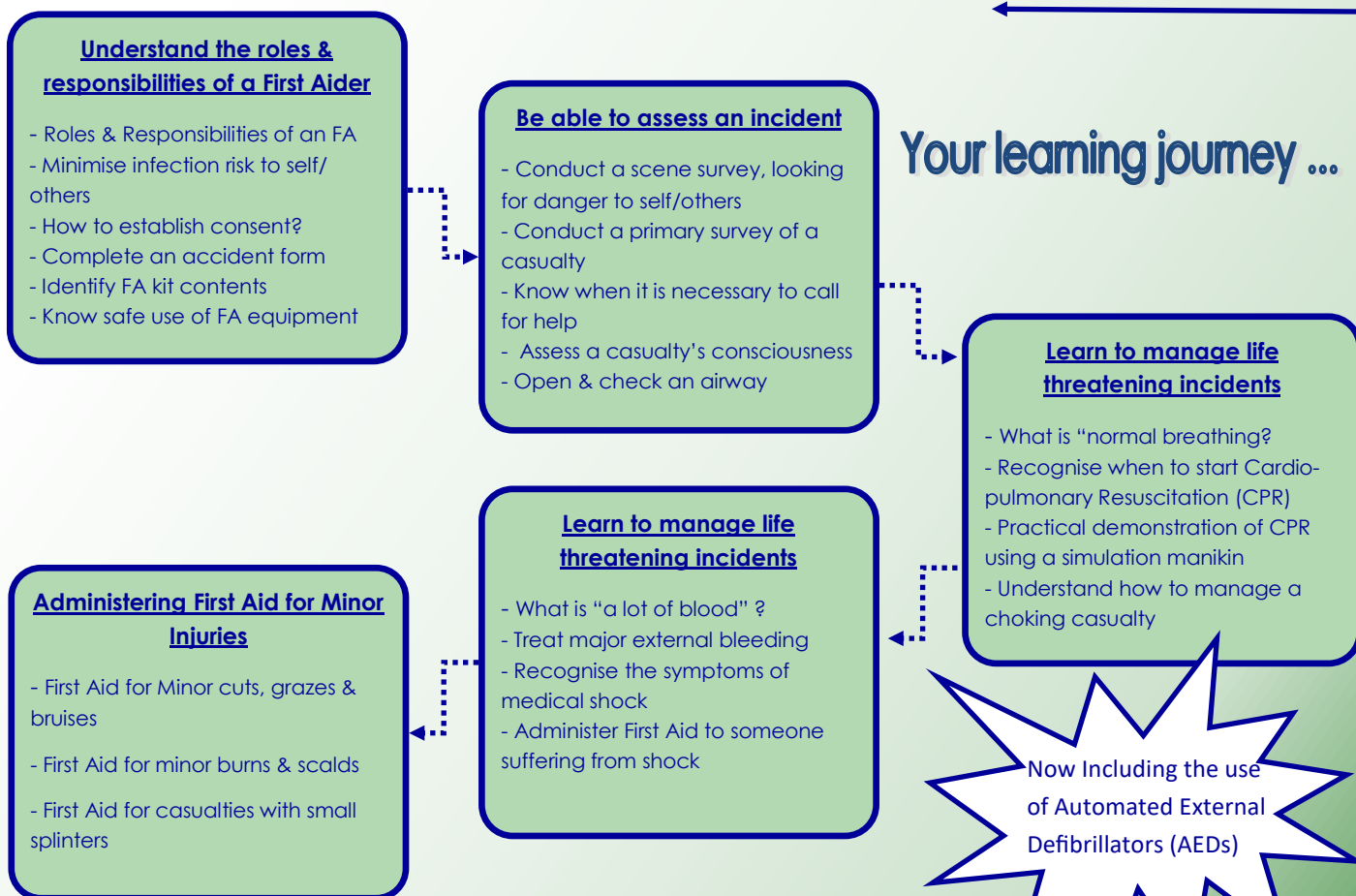
Qualification Overview

This course is designed for anyone wanting to become an accredited emergency first aider or appointed person. Appointed persons can hold specific responsibility for the reporting of incidents in the workplace as required by legislation affecting workplaces.

This qualification provides learners with skills and knowledge to deal with first aid situations in low risk work environments. It is valid for three years, although the Health & Safety Executive (HSE) advises that annual refresher training is taken.

The HSE requires you to undertake due diligence checks of the training provider you select. However, as our training qualifications are issued by AoFA Qualifications, an Ofqual approved awarding body, no additional costly checks are necessary.
